Some years ago Lillian (Frost) Long began a search for members of the Glover families who had settled in Marengo County, Alabama about 1819. The information which she collected then has formed the basis for this compilation and many other members of the family have helped expand it by generously contributing data, especially about the present generation.

Several lines, however, have been constructed, entirely from court records and are therefore subject to error. Marengo records are not indexed and often the pages have two numbers, hence pagination is not cited. I have attempted to give the source always. To save space, these sources are listed and then referred to only by the appropriate number.

There were numerous Glover families in Alabama during the first quarter of the nineteenth century. Many of them seem to have migrated from the old Ninety-Six District of South Carolina, and a search of records there would probably show the relationship. I have not attempted to delve into any by Alabama records and this work concerns only the descendants of Frederick Glover (d. 1797/98). His six children are designated by the letters A through F, and these letters, repeated, provide the key to the descendants of each line. As much information as is available about each family is given before going to the next of Frederick's children. Thus, the oldest child, Benjamin Glover, is A and all of his family is given before the next line B. Olivia or Mary Glover's descendants are listed.

No numbering scheme with so many names, especially with a repetition of the same one so often, is simple. But it is hoped that the system adopted is sufficiently clear. Perhaps some other member of the family can correct and enlarge this small beginning into a more complete Glover genealogy.

EARLY GLOVERS

There were Glovers settled in Virginia by the middle of the seventeenth century. It has been presumed that these Virginia Glovers were descendants of Richard Glover who emigrated to Virginia on the Assurance, July 24, 1635. This Richard Glover was a member of a merchant family living in Lond, another branch of which settled in New England. The Virginia emigrant is presumed to have settled in York Co., Va., marrying soon after his arrival. He left several sons, one of whom is said to be William Glover who was in Henrico Co., Va. in the latter part of the seventeenth century, but moved to the coastal region of North Carolina about 1690. This William Glover served briefly as a colonial governor of North Carolina. The William Glover below may be a son of the governor, or he may stem from the Glover families who were in Isle of Wight, Surry and Sussex counties in Virginia about the turn of the century.

Further research is needed to establish the line conclusively, but the following seems probable:

Very little is actually known about him. He was undoubtedly born in North Carolina, probably about 1740 as he must have been of legal age to administer his grandmother's estate in 1763. No records of his marriage have been found. Older generations seem to have thought he married Elizabeth Cato, and the name Cato was given to descendants. Other branches have stated that he married Sarah or Mary Bean, a daughter of William Bean or North Carolina. It is quite possible he was married twice.

Frederick Glover probably moved to South Carolina in the 1770's and there are indications that he owned land in the Ninety-Sixth District as early as 1772. This area of South Carolina was a frontier outpost then, the site of numerous skirmishes with Indians, Tories and British regulars. By 1790 the region was populous enough to be divided into several counties and the first census lists several families of Glovers, as well as Norwood HARRISES, WARDLAWs, and PORTERs, probably all closely related.

This is probably the Frederick Glover who served in the South Carolina militia during the Revolution and, on July 18, 1783 received payment of 3 pounds, 11 shillings, 5 pence for his services. (Salley, A. S. *State entries of soldiers issued in payment of claims against S. C. growing out of the Revolution.* Columbia, S. C., 1931 #642, 20. 6) At the same time John and Gregory Glover received payment for their services.

In the first census (1790) Abbeville District, S.C., Frederick Glover is listed as having in his household besides himself:

3 males over 16 years of age (Allen and John F.)
3 females

The oldest son, Benjamin, was in Wilkes Co., Ga. 1788/90 as his name appears on deeds and transactions in Georgia. His father-in-law, John Oliver was living in Georgia at that time. The two females are more likely to be Frederick's daughters. If this assumption is right, then Frederick Glover married twice, his first wife died before 1790, and he married again before 1793. Since no wife is mentioned in his will, the second wife must have died before 1797.

Frederick Glover's will is dated Dec. 31, 1796, proved Sept. 15, 1798 in Edgefield District, S. C. (Box 39, FK. 834)

Of these five children, Benjamin, Allen and Willey migrated to Marengo Co., Ala., and the children of Olivia and John Frederick came with them. Only Wiley Glover remained in South Carolina.

He probably married before 1790 and was living in Georgia at the time of the first census. Unfortunately Georgia's first census was burned and no record exists now. Other Glovers, probably closely related to the families living in western South Carolina, were in Wilkes and Elbert Counties 1788-96, separated only by the Savannah River from those in the Ninety-Sixth District. Benjamin and his brother Allen were in Abbeville when Ep. Ashury (Methodist) visited the region in 1815. The two brothers, with other members of the family migrated to central Alabama in 1818/19 and Benjamin died there the next year. He left no will but his estate was inventoried and settled Apr. 10, 1820. The appraisers were Nathaniel Sorwood (who became guardian of the younger son, Benjamin, Jr.) Burton Chappell, Isaac Perkins and Ludewick Moore. Allen Glover was a witness to the final settlement on May 21, 1821. It is thought that Benjamin had established a plantation near the present site of McKinley, but no graves were found.

Mary (Oliver) Glover, called "Polly" left a will dated Feb. 9, 1840 which names children and grandchildren (marked*) William J. Alston was her executor. Witnesses were Joseph N. Holman, Wilton Ford and Abel John. Issue:

At the time of the migration from South Carolina, Allen Glover was delayed so that his wife and children made the overland trip with other members of the family and had established a rude home by the time he arrived. He dealt extensively in lands, buying large tracts in Alabama and Mississippi, reaping a fortune from the resale. With George Strother Gaines, the Indian factor for southwestern Alabama, he operated a general store in Demopolis, Glover & Gaines. He was a Methodist and Bishop Asbury visited in his home in Abbeville, near Calhoun Falls, S. C. in 1814 and again in 1815. He left a will dividing his estate among his seven children and the surviving granddaughter, daughter of the one child who had predeceased him. But on the same day that the will was signed, by deed of gift he disposed of most of his property. Lands with uncleared titles were left for division by his executors: Williamson Allen Glover, Benjamin Nash Glover (his brother-in-law) and Francis Strother Lyon (his son-in-law)
